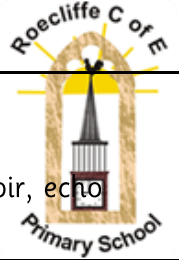


Spring Spelling Patterns



Spring 1	Spelling	Example words
Week 1	'I' sound spelt as 'y' Suffixes '-ness' and '-ful'	cry, why, fly, dry, July, by fairness, foolishness, tidiness, forgetful, successful, hopeful
Week 2	Suffixes '-ed', '-ing', '-er', '-est' Prefixes 'sub-' and 'tele-'	hiked/hiking/hiker, shine, hope, take, write, make, like, ride submarine, submerge, telephone, telescope
Week 3	'-le' at the end of a word Apostrophe for contractions	table, apple, bottle, little, middle, marble, kettle weren't, haven't, can't, didn't, hasn't, it's, I'll, they're
Week 4	Adding the ending 'y' to words ending in 'e' with a consonant before it. Words with alternative 'ch' and 's' sounds (mostly French in origin)	shine, scary, smoke, bone, shake chef, shop, sure, sugar, mission, special
Week 5	'ey' at the end of words Suffixes '-less' and '-ly'	donkey, monkey, valley, chimney, honey, money careful/careless/carelessly, useless/useful/usefulness, helpful/helpless
Week 6	'wr' sound Consolidation	wrap, wriggle, wrestler, wrist, write, written
Spring 2	Spelling pattern	
Week 1	Suffixes '-ed', '-ing', '-er', '-est' when the word ends in a single consonant after a single vowel	pat/patted/patting, drop/dropped/dropping
Week 2	Spell 'a' after a 'w' and 'qu' Prefixes 'super-' and 'auto-'	watch, want, wander, squash, quantity, quarrel superman, supernatural, autograph, autobiography
Week 3	Alternative 's' sound Homophones	treasure, usual meet/meat, hear/here, knot/not, quite/quiet, new/knew

Week 4	Apostrophe for possession Alternative 'ch' sound (mostly Greek in origin)	Megan's, Ahmed's, Sara's ache, anchor, Christmas, school, choir, echo
Week 5	Adding '-es' to words ending in a 'y' Words ending in '-tion'	carry/carries, copy/copies, lady/ladies, baby/babies, party/parties education, fiction, competition, direction, nation
Week 6	Consolidation
