We hope that you enjoyed your half term break. Here we are - back in the swing of things!

• Readathon and World Book Day activities next week

This is a reminder that we are encouraging the children at Roecliffe to read, read, read next week in the build up to World Book Day. Our school will hold a Readathon throughout the week.

The children read as much as they possibly can over our Readathon week and, if possible, they are sponsored for their efforts. The sponsorship will depend on their age and love of reading: some children might want to be sponsored per page, others per chapter and others for whole books. The money raised helps to provide books for children in hospitals and 20% of the money raised is given back to school to spend towards new books for the children.

The children can read anything they want e.g. books, magazines, newspapers, recipes, poems, comics, audio books e.t.c, so hopefully there will be something for everyone to enjoy!

Please support your child's sponsored read as much as you can. They will be helping children in hospitals get books, as well as helping themselves and our school receives free books worth 20% of our grand sponsorship total – so there really is something in it for everyone!

Book swap - every morning next week, starting on Monday 27th February, there will be the opportunity for children to bring unwanted books and hopefully be able to swap them for books they have not yet read. A table will be left on the playground for the children to bring and swap books as they wish. Make sure any books brought in are unwanted as, once they are swapped, it will be very hard to return these.

'Books and Breakfast'- on Friday 3rd March, we will open the doors at 8:30am to allow adults into their child's classroom to share a book together. Packaged breakfast items (e.g. pain au chocolat, chocolate chip brioche etc) will be available for a donation. Any money raised will go towards the 'Read for Good' charity. All children must be accompanied by an adult until the whistle is blown at 8.50.

Every playtime during our reading week, the children will have the opportunity to stay inside and read if they choose rather than going out to play. This will give them even more opportunities to read and raise even more money!

On World Book Day, children may dress up if they wish or could wear clues for their favourite book or character if they do not wish to go the whole hog with a costume. There is a special World Book day lunch menu on Thursday 2nd march based on Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.
