Next week we will celebrate Science week with a competition where children are encouraged to showcase experiments, investigations and demonstrate scientific understanding and knowledge. The children's findings can be presented in any way they feel is most appropriate. For example they could build a model, create a presentation or even a video of themselves carrying out an experiment, alongside explanations of the science and how the concept illustrates 'Connections'.

This is a great opportunity for children to show what they love about science and for parents and caregivers to collaborate with the children.

You can enter the competition by uploading photos, videos, and slides to your class's folder. A letter has been emailed out to parents this week with details of folders and links to these on Google Classroom.

Alternatively, children can bring their entry into school up until the 16th March.
