# **Music Rationale**

Intent and Implementation



### **Music Intent**



'Music is a universal language that embodies one of the highest forms of creativity. A high quality music education should engage and inspire pupils to develop a love of music and their talent as musicians, and so increase their self-confidence, creativity and sense of achievement.' **National Curriculum 2013** 

#### At Roecliffe C of E Primary School, our intent is:

- To provide children with enjoyable experiences so they have a positive attitude towards music.
- To expand children's knowledge and appreciation of music by providing them with opportunities to listen and explore different genres and composers.
- To encourage children to develop a 'have a go' attitude and self belief to explore different ideas when composing and performing music.



## **PHSE Implementation**



At Roecliffe C of E Primary school, we use a scheme called Kapow, which provides us with a well planned progression so children can continue to develop their knowledge as they progress through the school. This starts from Year 1 and continues through to Year 6.

Children will have opportunities to have hands on experience within their music lessons. They will be able to work collaboratively with others and also have the opportunity to work independently.

In EYFS, children have the opportunity to join in singing on a daily basis. Children also have a stage outside where they can use instruments to create shows and music.

During collective worship, music is played as the children enter. Each day is a different composer and this provides the opportunity for children to listen to a range of different composers and genres of music.

There are opportunities for children to take part in extracurricular activities, such as guitar lessons - which are available for children to do within school time.
