Dear parent / carer

Well, what a wonderful first week of our summer term! We have enjoyed sunny spring weather and a very positive start back at school, starting our new topics and seeing our friends at school again.

• First Aid Day

We are excited to let parents know that all of our pupils from Reception to Year 6 will be taking part in First Aid training at school on Monday 24th April. As you may already know, one of our school's key priorities this year is to support all of our pupils to develop their understanding of the importance of health, wellbeing and safety. The school has commissioned a First Aid expert from Sporting Influence to deliver training sessions to groups of children throughout the school day. Our younger children will learn the importance of avoiding injuries, keeping safe and how to look after a cut or a bruise, and our older children will learn the basics of administering first aid including head injuries, CPR and the recovery position.

Music lessons
