Arrival of children in the mornings

When the school gates open at 8.45am, the children in Reception - Year 6 should enter our school playground by the main single gate or the double gate near Class 1.

Children should arrive at school with their parents on the playground promptly at 8.45am and the staff then take over responsibility for the children when the whistle is blown at 8.50am. The single gate is closed and locked at 8.50am and the school's main entrance door is also closed.

The school does not condone children being dropped off in the road from parents' cars which have stopped in the road outside the school entrance as this increases the risk of road traffic accidents involving the children attending our school.

We ask that parents park up in time to walk their child to the school playground and supervise their child until the whistle is blown at 8.50am.

Children in Year 5 and Year 6 may be left on the school playground at 8.45am but all other children in Reception - Year 4 should be supervised by their parent/carer until 8.50am when the whistle is blown. Thank you for your support in keeping our children safe and punctual on their arrival at school.
