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# Phonics, Reading, Writing and Maths in EYFS





# Writing - Reception

- Children will start off writing small cvc words, which include sounds we have been learning (e.g. tap, tip, sat, sit).
- These will then move into small sentences - 'a man in a pan'.
- To help writing children need to know their sounds and the graphemes to match - lots of flash cards at home will help support this.
- Children also need to be able to segment - tip t/i/p.
- ***Lots of positivity and praise really helps support writing - it can be very tricky at times!***



# Maths - Reception

- We are currently following the 'White Rose' syllabus.
- Children will have a deeper understanding of numbers. E.g. all the different ways to make a number.
- Shape, space and measure will also be taught alongside number.
- Maths is very practical in EYFS and in reception they also learn how to form numbers and write down their number sentences.
- At home, it's great to add maths into everyday life. E.g. how many chips do you have on your plate? How many cars can you see?



# Enquiry Based Learning

- In Class 1, we have adopted the enquiry based learning approach.
- This helps our children to question things more and find out different ways to retrieve information.
