We hope you have had a great week. Please read on for our Roecliffe news...

• Egg boxes for our recyclable Christmas tree

Please bring in green painted egg boxes (6 or 12) by next Monday so that we can create our school's sustainable Christmas tree made from recycled materials. Our tree will be entered into the Boroughbridge Christmas Tree Festival in December. If you are not able to paint the egg box green at home, please bring it into school so that we can paint it. Thank you to those children and families who have brought an egg box into school already!

• Book sale

Our school is purchasing lots of lovely new books for our children in Reception to Year 2. These books will complement the Big Cat Little Wandle books we already have for our younger readers. Our newly purchased books are high quality early reading books and will complement the books we already have in place. All these books have been chosen by our staff with care so that we can ensure we have the best possible reading provision for our children at Roecliffe.

To help us raise some money so that we can fund this large purchase of reading books, we are having a book sale on Friday 8th December.

The book sale will start at 3pm when nursery parents collect their children and will continue through until approximately 4pm so that parents can also browse and buy.

The books are in excellent condition and have been used in school for reading practice with our younger children (Reception - Year 2).
