We wanted to take this opportunity to let all our parents know that we will continue to provide swimming lessons for the Year 2 and Year 3 children in Class 2 throughout next academic year. We believe that it is important that these children have the opportunity to develop a vital life skill at a young age over the course of the two years that they are in Class 2.

School swimming lessons are considerably cheaper than private swimming lessons and the school pays for the transport to the Jack Laugher Health and Wellness Centre in Ripon each week at an annual cost of approx £5000.
