Describe the lifestyle and culture of the Maya people, including their religion, language, and social structure. 3. Analyse the achievements of the Maya in fields such as mathematics, astronomy, and agriculture, and understand how their ideas influenced later cultures. 4. Evaluate the reasons for the decline and collapse of the Maya civilization, including natural disasters, conflicts with other groups, and environmental factors. Autumn 2 Sculpture making- pottery The children will: -Develop an understanding of how the Maya civilisation used pottery as crucial parts of their daily life, and the varying purposes these objects served, such as for storing food, ceremonial fitudis, or trade-Recognise common features of Maya ceramics, such as their intricate carvings and hieroglyphic inscriptions, the uses of natural resources and the predominance of designs inspired by animals and godsDevelop core skills in sculpting, painting and firing. They should understand the key steps involved in making pottery, from modelling to glazing and firingUnderstand the traditional methods used to decorate Maya ware, such as slip pointing, the inclusion of intricate design motifs, and the use of natural pigments.
