• Did you know...?

Between 15 September and 31 December, young people aged 18 or under will pay only £1 for a single journey on most bus routes in North Yorkshire.

The £1 fare scheme is funded by UK Government. It is available on most bus journeys within North Yorkshire and to York and the Tees Valley.

The fare scheme does not include school routes, tours and bus services closed to the public. More details can be found here: <u>Bus service changes and news | North Yorkshire Council</u>

• Supporting Your Child with KS2 Maths - free online parent/ carer support Adult Learning North Yorkshire is offering a free online course, 'Supporting Your Child with Key Stage 2 Maths'.
